The root cause of all evil, heedlessness

Heedless of their duties towards Allah, intentionally turning away from His remembrance, the Hereafter and neglecting the account to come on Judgement Day.

Every intelligent person knows that Shaytān has no way to [attack] him except from three angles:

 Heedlessness. One who remembers [Allāh] is in an impenetrable fortress. If he becomes forgetful and heedless, he opens the gates of the fortress, and the enemy enters, after which it is difficult to expel him.

Two: Increase and extravagance; to have more than one needs.

Three: caring for what is not his business in all matters of life.

And in this ayah is an indication to the importance of (having) prescence of heart when performing dhikr of Allah. And that the person who remembers Allah with (only) his tongue and not his heart, (then) the barakah (blessing) is removed from his actions and his time to the extent that his deeds become lost."

Heedlessness creates love and attention only of the life of this world and removes the striving towards the Akhirah

#### Causes

Belief in the longevity of Life, being away from gatherings of remembrance/knowledge, not remembering death, following your desires, bad company, failure to account yourself ....

### Cure

Engage in Dhikr, renew your intentions, abandon sinning, remember death(visit the graves), Du'a, account yourself....
