SUBJECTS

Baghdaadiyyah

All students are taught **Baghdaadiyyah** as it will equip them with the foundation of reading, writing and correct pronunciation. A spacious clean layout making the content accessible, easy and friendly for children to read. It Features the '**Uthmani script**' calligraphy style used in the world-famous Madina Mus-haf as a result making it easier for our students life-long journey with the Qur'an. Students will also be tested from Baghdaadiyah throughout their time at Al-Bayaan through dictation, testing their skills of listening and writing.

Qur'an Memorisation

All students will complete the memorisation of Juz 'Amma as part of our syllabus. Parents will have the option to continue the memorisation of the Qur'an or begin our Qur'an Tilaawah program.

Qur'an Tilaawah

After the completion of the Juzz 'Amma parents will have the option to choose our Tilaawah Syllabus. This syllabus covers the entire recitation of the Qur'an.
